Port Whitby Marina

Port Whitby Marina, operated by the Town of Whitby, is located on one of the finest natural harbours on Lake Ontario. Easily accessible from Highway 401 and Highway 12, this 420 slip full-service marina attracts nearly 1,000 boaters annually and is home to the Town's Harbour Day community event which attracts over 5,000 visitors.

Whitby's Waterfront Master Plan

The Waterfront Master Plan has an area covering approximately 16.6 square kilometers, including over 370 hectares of conservation lands, over 100 hectares of passive open space, over 60 hectares of parkland and community facilities. The waterfront shoreline of Lake Ontario is 11 kilometers in length, over 90% of which is under public ownership or lease. This provides a significant amount of lands where public access to the waterfront is available. Several of Whitby's premier destination parks and open spaces are located in the area and serve local residents and tourists from the GTA.
